This will be our seventh year to invite the citizens of Steamboat to perform the judging duties. These volunteers are not judging professionals, but they enjoy the duties, and are keen to do a good job. It also helps us in providing the large labor pool needed to inspect over five hundred mustangs.

Each pair of judges will inspect every car within a specific class, promoting better judging continuity. Your car will be graded using a five point scale, focusing on cleanliness, craftsmanship and attention to detail. The judges will evaluate the engine, interior, exterior, wheels/tires and overall appearance. Each category is worth 5 points for a maximum of 25 points. We encourage you to leave the hood and windows open, as the judges are instructed to not enter any cars unless specific permission is given.

We are very pleased to involve our Steamboat Springs volunteers in our event and are confident you will also welcome their participation in the Roundup. Our goal is to organize a fair and fun competition, but we must insist.... all judging decisions will be final. Judging documents won't be made public. I will be manning the judges table in case anyone needs assistance.
